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MEDICAL LIABILITY RELEASE

I do also authorize adult workers with St. Peter Catholic Church and its programs to consent to any examination, X-ray, anesthetic, medical, surgical diagnosis/treatment and hospital care which is deemed advisable by, and is rendered under the general or special supervision of any physician or surgeon licensed under the provisions of the Medical Practice Act on the medical staff of a licensed hospital, whether such diagnosis or treatment is rendered at the office of said physician at such hospital. I assume the responsibility of all medical bills, if any.

- *Parents are requested to walk each child into the Ministry Center at the start of CCD/CC. An adult {DRE or Catechist} stands at the top of the Center steps watching the pick-up of each child by parent / guardian.*
- *Each child is escorted to the restroom and as DRE or Catechists, we remain outside, waiting to escort child back to class. If the restroom is already occupied by another we do not allow the child to enter until they have the facilities to use alone, likewise, we do not allow others to enter restroom until child leaves with DRE/Catechist.*
 - *During CCD/CC hours the DRE remains within the hallways for building security}*
