

Funding is limited and unfortunately, some candidates may receive less than the amount requested or may be denied a scholarship and invited to reapply the following year.

The requirements for applicants are as follows:

- A completed application and a personal interview.
- Participation in parish activities such as altar servers and youth group.
- ullet A 2.5 grade point average while attending high school, university, college, or vocational school, whichever is applicable.
- An official transcript from the educational institution they are attending.
- Evidence of the efforts made to obtain funding from other sources, including but not limited to parents.



St. Peter's Youth Ministry will once again be heading to Orlando for the Steubenville Youth Conference July 27-29th. This conference is open to all teens entering High School in the fall of 2018.

What is a Steubenville Youth Conference you ask?
