The requirements for applicants are as follows:

- A completed application and a personal interview.
- Participation in parish activities such as altar servers and youth group.
- ♦ A 2.5 grade point average while attending high school, university, college, or vocational school, whichever is applicable.
- An official transcript from the educational institution they are attending.
- Evidence of the efforts made to obtain funding from other sources, including but not limited to parents.
