

Announcing the New Music Director at St. Peter Catholic Church

We are SO excited to welcome Megan Constantine as our new St. Peter Music Director! When Charlotte Rudy decided to retire as music director, she made phone call after phone call in search of someone who could direct the choir year-round. The Holy Spirit must have guided her because Charlotte was led to Dr. Megan Constantine who came to Key West from Cleveland Ohio in February of 2017.

Megan learned to play piano by ear at the age of 5. Her first job playing piano, five days a week, at the age of 15, was at Malluis Ice Cream Parlor in Lakewood, Ohio. As a teen-ager she played at Ferris' Steak House in Cleveland, Ohio---since she was so young, her parents had to come with her!

Now that she is all grown up, Megan plays in Key West at the Gardens hotel, the Curry Mansion, Sunset Pier, Schooner Wharf, the Casa Mariana, and was the Musical Director of the recent Fringe Theater's production of "The Conch Republic".

She enjoys cycling and used to race bicycles. She also enjoys the challenge of keeping her 1968 VW convertible running. You may have seen her, Fr. Jets, Megan's two children—Johnny age 10 and Vinny age 3, and some of our parishioners, pushing the VW around our parking lot in a vain effort to start it the first Sunday she came to visit us!

Megan graduated *Cum Laude* from the University of Akron, earned a Masters Degree at Cleveland State University in 2005, and earned her Doctorate in Music Education at Case Western Reserve University in 2011. She majored in tuba and string bass (so if you see her at Mass one day with tuba or string bass one day, try not to look surprised). In her dissertation she explored how different types of musicians learn music and has a chapter in Ann Clements' book <u>Alternative Approaches in Music Education</u>. She has a lovely voice and sang with the Cleveland Orchestra Chorus from 2002-2004—no doubt almost as exciting as singing with the St. Peter Choir! A music educator for eight years, Megan has taught band, choir, general music and strings throughout northeast Ohio.

Megan plays keyboard with joy and a sense of fun that is contagious. We feel very blessed to have her leading our choir.
