

Since 1 January 2017, and because of the generous support of our parishioners, the following items have been sent to missions in Africa:

1220 handmade mission rosaries were sent to Christ the King Priory. Missionary Benedictine Monks accept donated mission rosaries and distribute them in support of their Rosary Project of Africa.

2 lbs of stamps were sent to help the Franciscan Missions. Franciscan Missions provide benefit to the less fortunate in missions throughout the world in many ways through fundraising efforts. One effort is the sale of donated stamps. With the fundraising proceeds, the Franciscan Friars can provide lifesaving gifts of medicine and treatments, food, water, clothing, education, secure shelter for poor and marginalized children and families, and delivery hope for a better future.
