MISSION COLLECTION REPORT

Since 1 January 2017 and because of the generous support of our parishioners, the following items have been sent to missions in Africa:

1220 handmade mission rosaries were sent to Christ the King Priory. Missionary Benedictine Monks accept donated mission rosaries and distribute them in support of their Rosary Project of Africa.

2 lbs of stamps were sent to help the Franciscan Missions. Franciscan Missions provide benefit to the less fortunate in missions throughout the world in many ways through fundraising efforts. One effort is the sale of donated stamps. With the fundraising proceeds, the Franciscan Friars can provide lifesaving gifts of medicine and treatments, food, water, clothing, education, secure shelter for poor and marginalized children and families, and delivery hope for a better future.

236 eye glasses have been donated to the missions in Africa for the vision impaired. The Monks in the Monastery of the Benedictine Mission House send our donated glasses to their clinics in areas such as Tanzania, Kenya, and Hanga Abbey to help bring light to the blind.

A note of thanks to Dr. Roger Otto, OD, PA who donates (to us) all used eyeglasses that have been turned into his office.

You can help support the Missions Ministry by putting your donations of cancelled stamps and old, outdated eyeglasses in the collection basket or in the box in Connie's Office. Your thoughtfulness will help someone in need who is unable to enjoy the beauty of the stars at night, bright flowers and beautiful landscapes by day.

Peterites' generous donations help make it possible for these vital missions to continue and to touch so many lives. Thank you.

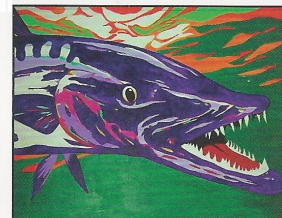

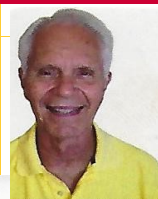
