This Wed., Aug. 15th we celebrate the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary A Holy Day of Obligation

Vigil Mass at 6pm Tuesday—Holy Day Mass Wednesday at 9am

Wednesday, Catholics around the world mark the Feast of the Assumption of Mary, commemorating the end of her earthly life and assumption into heaven. But while the feast day is a relatively new one, the history of the holiday—and the mystery behind it traces its roots back to the earliest days of the Church.

According to St. John of Damascus, in the 5th century, at the Council of Chalcedon in 451, Roman Emperor Marcian requested the body of Mary, Mother of God. St. Juvenal, who was bishop of Jerusalem replied “that Mary died in the presence of all the Apostles, but that her tomb, when opened upon the request of St. Thomas, was found empty; whereupon the Apostles concluded that the body was taken up to heaven” the saint recorded.

The dogma was defined officially this past century by Pope Pius XII. “By the authority of our Lord Jesus Christ, of the Blessed Apostles Peter and Paul, and by our own authority, we pronounce, declare, and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma: that the Immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heavenly glory,” the Pope wrote. The Assumption was dogmatically defined by Pope Pius XII on November 1, 1950. Catholic News Agency

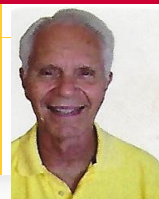
