Criteria: The envelope must include \$5.00 cash or check and your name and the date on the outside as well, please—this is in addition to your regular offering.

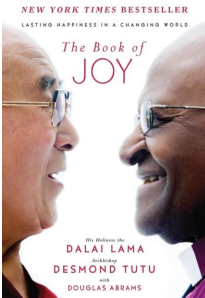


Next weekend marks the

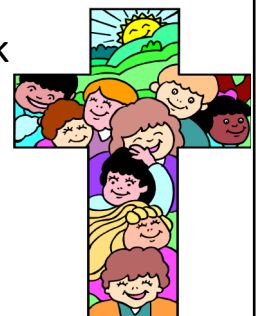


Join the Choir Today!!

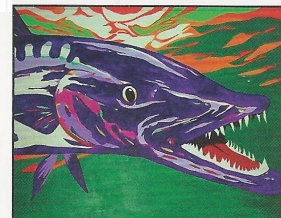

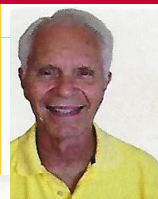
