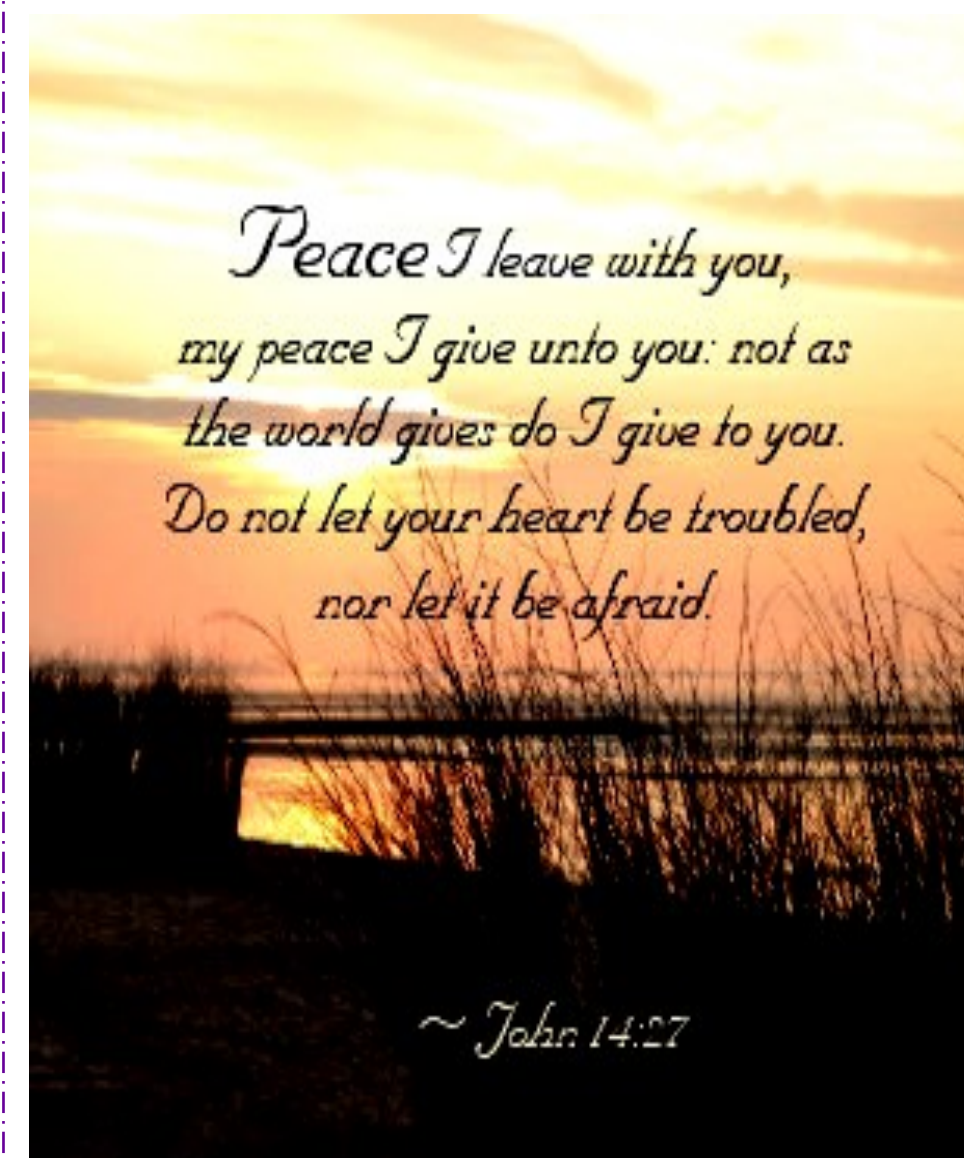

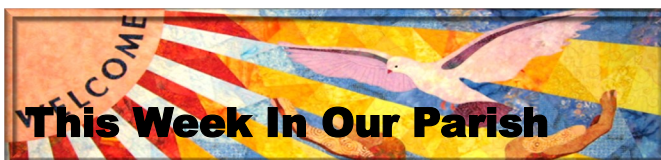

Born and raised in Philadelphia, Jack and Alice were High School sweethearts (although they went to different schools), and were married on May 30th, 1964. They have 3 children, 5 grandchildren and 1 1/2 great grandchildren (the latest one due to arrive in September).

Jack, (a Vietnam Veteran), served in the Marine Corps (after graduating from High School) from 1962 to 1966.

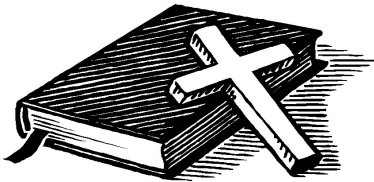
