





# ST. PETER REBUILD STATUS AS OF 7 FEBRUARY 2020

CHAIR, ST. PETER FINANCE COUNCIL AND BUILDING COMMITTEE

As you know, we have been jumping through many "hoops ", both with Monroe County and especially with our insurers.

After gaining "conceptual approval" from Insurers (i.e. we had a design that we could afford), our permits were submitted on June 14, 2019.

Monroe County subsequently approved them on December 9, 2019!

So what's the holdup? Why aren't we building?

Once approved, our General Contractor (FL Lemark) must add their major subcontractors (foundation, site, electrical) on to the physical permit before it can be picked up and work commenced. FL Lemark was ready to go when our Insurers decided they were going to exercise their option to approve subcontractors bids before approval! They continued to drag their feet, and on January 14, 2020, a "Notice to Proceed" was issued by ADoM (Archdiocese of Miami).

On February 4, 2020, after assigning the major subcontractors, we were issued our building "Permit Card"...we have it in hand! And we are happy to say that 3 of the initial 5 subcontractors are LOCAL firms!

So what now? There is a new process in place for audit and review, during which no construction can occur. The **County has UP TO 30 days** to complete this, and the **State has UP TO 45 days** after that. **IF** both took their full allotted time, **April 19,2020** would be our official start date! [However, exemptions on those requirements were filed recently.]

BUT, there is much that can be done before that, including site preparation and other activities that do not require an Inspection until complete. FL Lemark is coordinating those activities with our initial subcontractors, and we expect to see activity on site fairly soon. They are also reviewing their schedule to assess if they can hold the original completion date.

We will attempt to keep you informed regularly, check the Bulletin. Major items we will bring to your attention after Masses.

Thank you all for your patience. We will need your continued support and diligence.
