

Construction:

Ground clearing has been completed ahead of schedule. Materials for foundation forms are on site—more on their way. So far, we have not been impacted by the Coronavirus, and we continue to pray for the health and safety of all our workers. The roadblock at the top of the Keys has not substantially delayed either materials or workers—we remain on schedule! Our team is awaiting bids for construction of the

new temporary entrance. It will be between the pavilion and the Food Bank and wind around to our temporary parking lot. Exit will be along the fence line in front of the Pavilion. More on that in coming weeks.

It is no surprise that the number of clients has risen dramatically in the last few weeks with all the layoffs in our area. A small group of brave and dedicated volunteers is preparing bags for distribution on Mondays and Wednesdays only. Food supplies are scarce and unpredictable. 

CCD Update:


Good news!! The Confirmation class will resume meeting, virtually, this Sunday, April 5, at 9:30am via Zoom.




They had a trial run and all students were able to log on. Please keep them and their teachers in your prayers!
