A Grateful Reflection on our Confirmation

January 17, 2021

The six students sat in their red robes in the Pavilion Church as the ceremony of Confirmation was about to begin. Finally, it was time for the introductions—Baptismal Name followed by Confirmation Name. As they stood, one only had to glance behind them to see their Parents and Families sitting proudly enjoying this moment. We are so grateful to these Parents who first brought their child with their chosen Godparents and spoke for them in Baptism; these Parents who brought them to our CCD Program and stood by them in the Sacraments of Penance and First Eucharist; these Parents about to see their son or daughter fully initiated into this Parish of St. Peter.

The moment had finally arrived when these six teenagers would speak the words: "I DO" for themselves, as they, of their own volition, renewed the Baptismal Promises which their Parents and Godparents spoke for them so many years before.

This is our Faith...the Faith of the Church...in Christ Jesus, our Lord.

As Fr. Jets waited for the first Confirmandi to step forward, we reflect on just how lucky we are as a Parish. It was Fr. Each student to be Confirmed approached Father to be sealed with the Gift of the Holy Spirit and anointed with the Sacred Chrism as his/her Sponsor stood firm with a right hand on the right shoulder and resolved to accept the responsibility to help them develop as active Parishioners, a lifetime commitment. We are grateful to these Sponsors from near and far and especially those who came to stand in Proxy for our newly confirmed in this most unusual year. We, as a Parish Community, are blessed indeed.

And blessed, especially, are we in St. Peter Parish to have had our Catechist/Teachers Rowena Frank and Carla Threadgill and their faithful assistant Kelly Threadgill, who have been so devoted to these students for more than two and a half years. This day has been a long time in coming and we are most grateful for your perseverance.

It took many people to prepare for and bring this Confirmation Day to fruition. We thank Roberta our Sacristan, Steve, our Master of Ceremony, Laurita our Lector, Rosalinda our Photographer, Clara, Bob and Megan our Musicians, and Connie who have contributed so much to our special day.

In conclusion, for just a moment, I would ask all who are reading this to REFLECT on your own Confirmation Name and renew once more your Confirmation vows. Know that the Holy Spirit is, was, and always will be with us and that He bids us to go forth and bring His fruits: Love, Joy, Peace, Patience, Kindness, Gentleness and Self Control to our so troubled world.

Jesus, in today's Gospel, promises to all Confirmed: "I will make you FISHERS OF MEN."

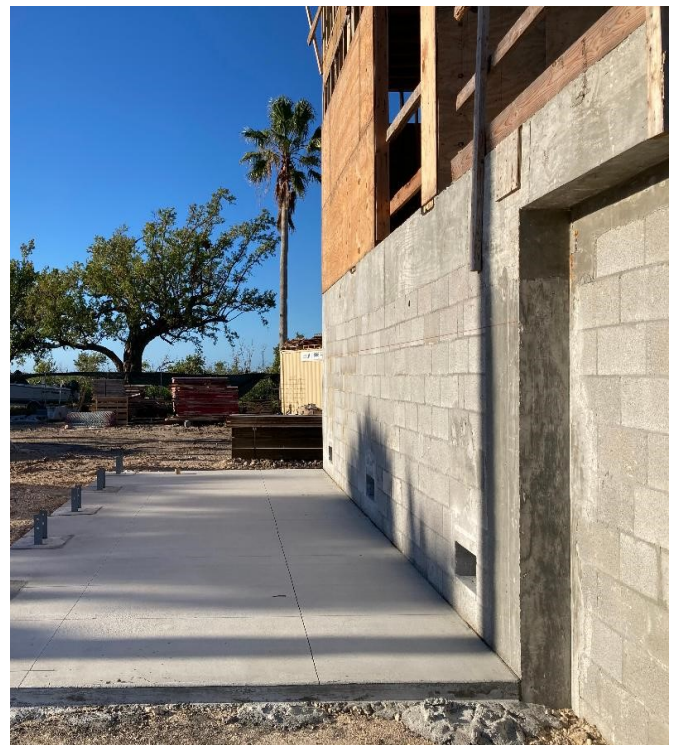
