

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Since the Fall of the Berlin Wall and the end of communism in Eastern Europe the Church in the United States has supported the Church in the countries of the former Soviet Bloc through our annual collection for the Church in Eastern Europe.

This collection supports many of the charitable activities of the Church in these countries in addition to helping rebuild Church infrastructure, including parish churches, pastoral centers, seminaries, as well as supporting the resurgence of religious life in these nations.

For example, in Belarus, through the Tabita program, operated by Caritas Belarus, the collection supports and assists people with disabilities with their physical, social, psychological, and spiritual needs.

However, the grave situation in Ukraine has created a world of pain and need that the Church is seeking to address both in Ukraine and in the countries, such as Poland, where many Ukrainian nationals have sought refuge.


