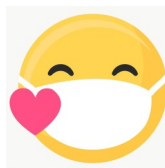

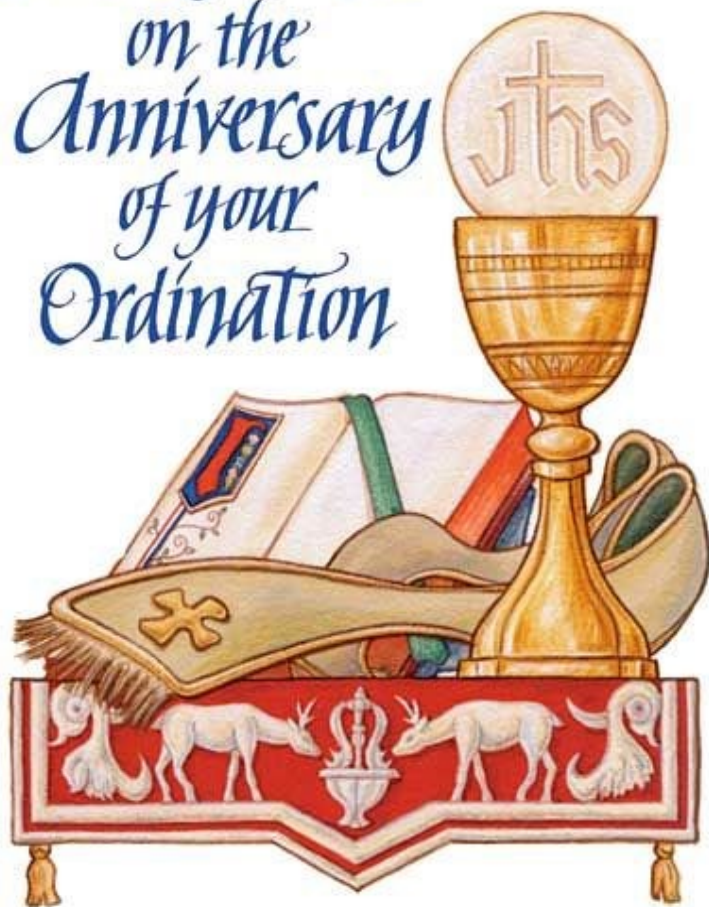

He was the first Filipino to be ordained in the  
Archdiocese of Miami. In addition to his du-  
ties as pastor here, he is the Director of the  
Office of Ministry to Cultural Groups  
of the Archdiocese.

Fr. Jets was assigned to  
St. Peter's in August of 2017—seven weeks  
before the arrival of Hurricane Irma. He has  
been an incredible blessing to this parish  
during what could have been a disastrous  
period and instead has been a time of  
growth, renewal, and bonding that has  
resulted in a beautiful new church and  
an energized parish. God is good!

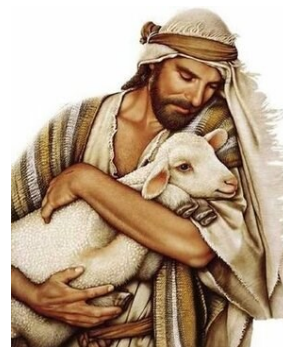

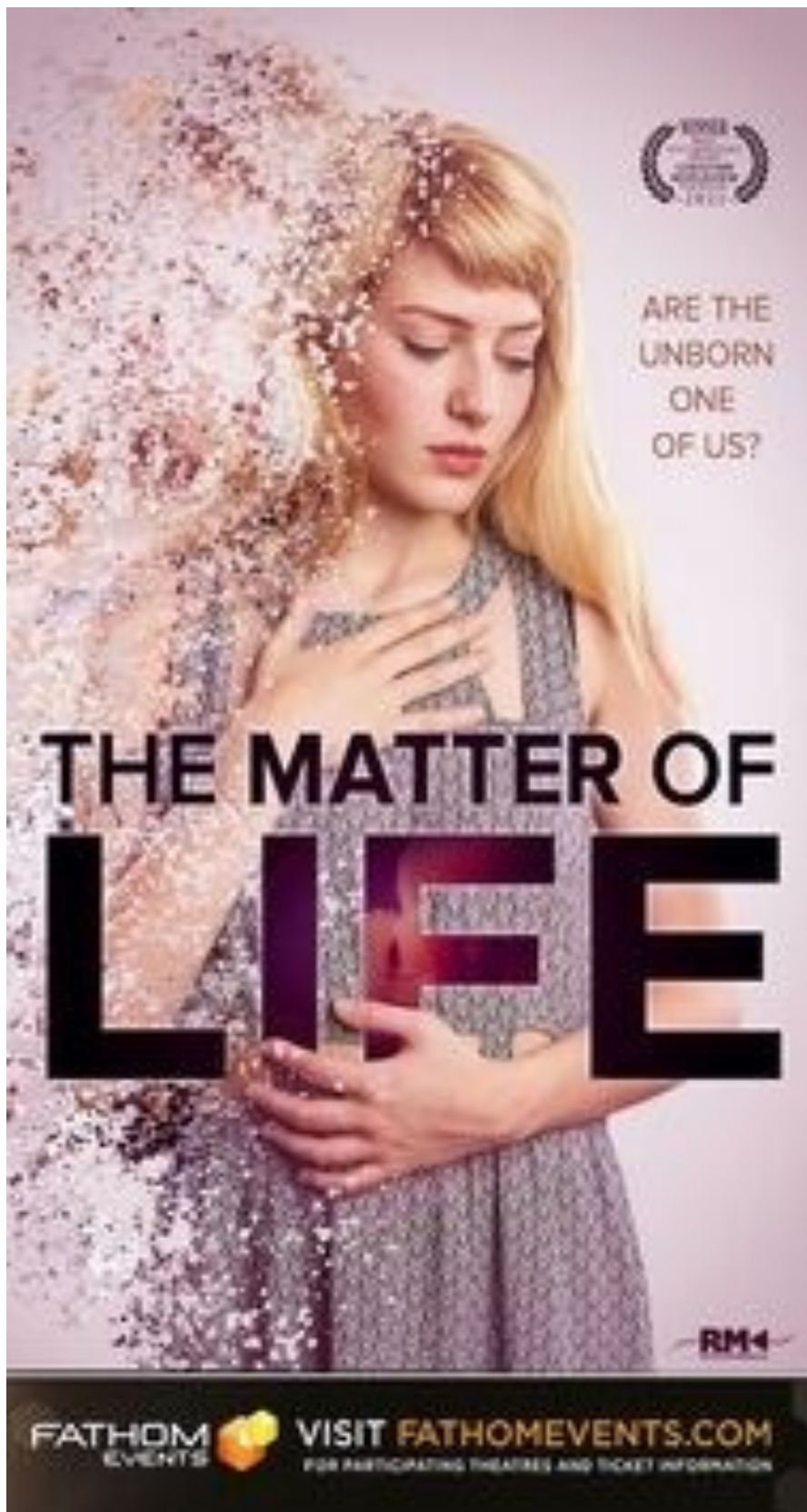

### Education Fund Scholarship Program

(Application forms are available in the parish office)

The St. Peter Catholic Church Education Fund mission is to help members of the parish pursue their educational goals. Scholarships are awarded on an annual basis. The funds are earmarked for tuition. Funding is limited and unfortunately, some candidates may receive less than the amount requested or may be denied a scholarship and invited to reapply the following year.

The requirements for applicants are as follows:

- ♦ A completed application and a personal interview.
- ♦ Participation in parish activities.
- ♦ A 2.5 grade point average while attending high school, university, college or vocational school—whichever is applicable.
- ♦ An official transcript from the educational institution they are attending.
- ♦ Evidence of the efforts made to obtain funding from other sources, including, but not limited to parents.

You must call the parish office in order to be considered.

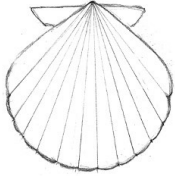

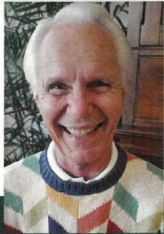

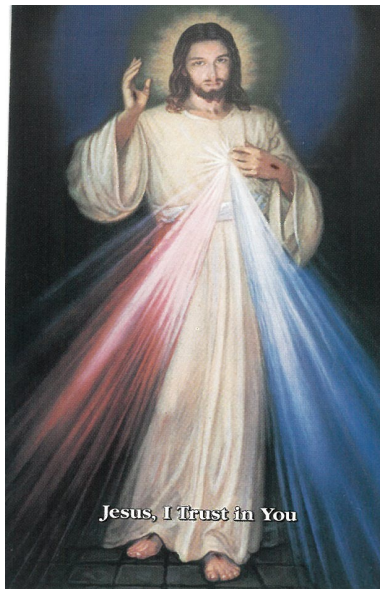
