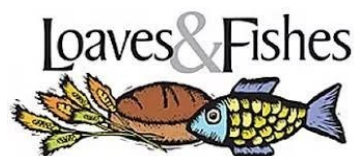

Brad is a chef. 6 months ago he was in ICU after having his small bowel removed for advanced cancer. Right now both his budget and his diet are very restricted.

Ann cares for her husband who has advanced Alzheimers. He is up all night roaming around the house. They receive \$16 a month in food stamps. Ann visits the food bank when her husband finally falls asleep. She appreciates the food, but thrives on being able to socialize.

Judy is bipolar. She is receiving counseling. She has a very hard time making decisions. We try to coordinate foods that she can use together to make a healthy meal.

Abraham is caring for his dying wife. She eats very little and is bed bound. His needs include nutritional supplements, laundry detergents and sanitary wipes so he can bathe her ever day

Doris is raising her five children, a nephew and her sister and her adult disabled son. Doris works full time in the cleaning staff at a large hotel.

Each of our people has a story. Every day I realize that one mistake, one bad choice, or simple bad break and that could be me—embarrassed to be asking for free food.

I wonder as Jesus slept outside, walking from city to city, not bathing, depending on strangers for food might be just like one of our people. I wonder if Jesus were with us in person today, would we be turning him away, judging him, and dismissing him as worthless?
