



Our Coordinator of Religious Education, Rosalinda Hally, was one of 700 who attended a **Eucharistic Retreat** in Miami given by the Servants of the Pierced Hearts of Jesus and Mary on Saturday, June 10th. The theme of the one-day event was “I Will Always Be With You” .

The day began with Mass, and the intentions of all in attendance were presented as an offering. Following Mass, there were 4 separate talks during the day. Sr. Evelyn SCTJM spoke on the “*Encyclical Letter Ecclesia De Eucharistica*” of his Holiness Pope John Paul II. The Church draws her life from Christ in the Eucharist—by Him she is fed and by Him she is enlightened.” The Eucharist is both a mystery of faith and “a mystery of light.” Whenever the church celebrates the Eucharist, the faithful can, in some way, can relive the experience of the two disciples on the road to Emmaus. “Their eyes were opened and they recognized Him.” (Lk 24:31) The day ended with Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Adoration.

Rosalinda also spent time venerating a First Class relic of St. John Paul II and two First Class relics of Blessed Carlo Acutis. A grace-filled retreat!!

This retreat is part of the National Eucharistic Revival: the 3 year event to restore




