The Christmas Season (for Catholics)

December 25 - The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord

Roman Catholics (and some other Christians) mark the end of the liturgical Christmas season with the celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which falls this year on Monday, January 8, right after the Feast of the Epiphany, January 7th. Ordinary Time begins the day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

<u>Fun fact:</u> Centuries ago, the baptism of Christ was the primary event celebrated as part of the feast of the Epiphany, along with the visit of the Magi and other events from the childhood of Jesus. *Epiphany* means "manifestation" or "appearance." So while the baptism of Christ marks the beginning of his public ministry, it is also part of his "manifestation" or "appearance"—one of the events signaling that God has broken into human history in a unique way.



- Installation of new parish hall 2ea. CGIC Impact Commercial Entry Double doors & 2ea. CGIC Impact Commercial Entry Single doors with easy durable locking hardware. IN PERMIT PHASE-AWAITING INSTALLATION DATE.
- **Plumbing**: Haskins has begun the process of correcting combination within flushing mechanism for 10 toilets to properly flush as property is still under low water pressure. Electrical has been upgraded to allow pressure correcting pump. Food Pantry 1ea. Hand sink & 1ea. Food Washing sink has been ordered. Other Haskins work scheduled permanent installed water line for pavilion, 2 ordered sinks within the garage one for garage use and other within planned Stained-Glass location.


