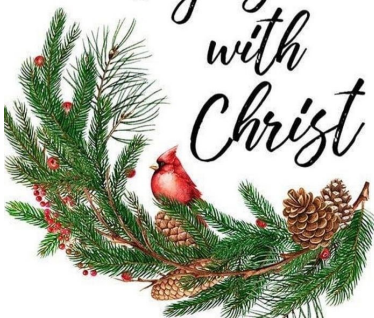

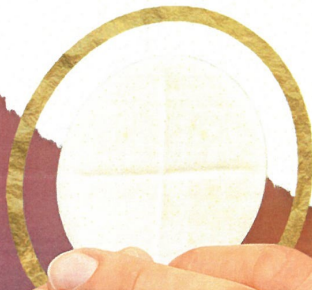

## **The Christmas Season (for Catholics)**

*December 25 – The Feast of the Baptism of the Lord*

Roman Catholics (and some other Christians) mark the end of the liturgical Christmas season with the celebration of the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, which falls this year on Monday, January 8, right after the Feast of the Epiphany, January 7th. Ordinary Time begins the day after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

Fun fact: Centuries ago, the baptism of Christ was the primary event celebrated as part of the feast of the Epiphany, along with the visit of the Magi and other events from the childhood of Jesus. *Epiphany* means “manifestation” or “appearance.” So while the baptism of Christ marks the beginning of his public ministry, it is also part of his “manifestation” or “appearance”—one of the events signaling that God has broken into human history in a unique way.

## **PROPERTY MANAGEMENT UPDATE**

### **CURRENT PROJECT LIST:**

- ***Installation of new parish hall 2ea. CGIC Impact Commercial Entry Double doors & 2ea. CGIC Impact Commercial Entry Single doors with easy durable locking hardware. – IN PERMIT PHASE-AWAITING INSTALLATION DATE.***
- ***Plumbing:*** Haskins has begun the process of correcting combination within flushing mechanism for 10 toilets to properly flush as property is still under low water pressure. Electrical has been upgraded to allow pressure correcting pump. Food Pantry 1ea. Hand sink & 1ea. Food Washing sink has been ordered. Other Haskins work scheduled permanent installed water line for pavilion, 2 ordered sinks within the garage one for garage use and other within planned Stained-Glass location.
- ***Electrical:*** Florida Keys Electric to replace defective exterior LED light fixtures, Accessed and designing correction to “Hot Switch” overload issue within the Parish Hall. Remove and relocate exterior Rectory garage opening header lamps to allow for pending garage doors.
- ***Elevator:*** Remains Out of Order as newly purchased replacement board, rectifier, and additional parts fail upon installation. Awaiting response for action plan. Due to continual no-service condition, bids to replace have been requested. – Finance Council to review pending bids.
- ***Rick’s Garage Doors:*** To install on Rectory garage, 2 White Electric Remote-control Nautilus rolled shutters – Rated for Impact and Security. Installation upon delivery of doors.
- ***Vital Signs:*** To install Property Signage: Monument Marquee Sign, Lighted Name, Directional Property Signage, Building Signs, two-sided glass covered postings board. Entering Permit Phase.
- ***Installation NOW of Sanctuary Handrails.***

### **PROPERTY UPDATE-LEGACY MINISTRY**

- ***Architect Juan Calvo with the help of our maintenance gentleman Chris, have now installed by required design, remaining Statues and Legacy items: St. Michael the Archangel; Chapel paintings; rest for statue Infant of Prague and sanctuary Ambry {Pending exterior individual 3 piece inlays remain for installation}. Juan completed and installed within the Narthex the awaiting boards which will allow me to move forward with the previous on hold engraving plaque project.***
- ***To begin the engraving of plaque project, donors will be notified to approve the proof prior to engraving.***

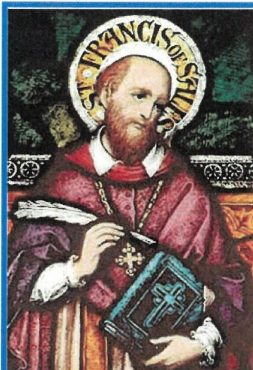
