
Next weekend—-April 14th is the second Sunday of the



Funding is limited and unfortunately, some candidates may receive less than the amount requested or may be denied a scholarship and invited to reapply the following year.

The requirements for applicants are as follows:

- A completed application .
- Participation in Parish Ministries.
- A 2.5 grade point average while attending high school, university, college, or vocational school, whichever is applicable.
- An official transcript from the educational institution they are attending.
- Evidence of the efforts made to obtain funding from other sources, including but not limited to parents.

- <u>Completed applications must be returned by April 15th.</u>
